Eligibility

- Properties must not be owned by the entering firm (including showcase projects completed at a firm's facility).
- Projects that have previously received a GOLD award in a category may not be re-entered in the same category.
- A project may be entered in more than one category but each entry must have its own unique name, description and photos. Separate entry fees apply.
- If you'd like to submit an entry for a Decade Award and are unsure if your project is eligible, please reach out to NALP.



JUDGING

All awards are determined based on a 100-point scoring system. Points are awarded by a judging panel that is comprised of industry professionals from all regions of the United States. Projects are judged based on appearance, degree of difficulty and other criteria specific to each category. Entries do not compete against each other; they are judged on their own merit. Company names are kept anonymous from the judges. Entrants are permitted to see their scores and any comments the judges may have provided. There are no set number of awards given per award type and entries are not guaranteed an award.

Now Accepting Entries – Do Not Miss Out!

Deadline: July 31, 2026

Entering the Awards of Excellence is easy. Just follow these basic steps.

Visit landscapeprofessionals.org/aoe and select **Enter Now**. (You will need your NALP login to access).

Choose your best projects. Enter projects/properties that are at the right stage of maturity. Plants should be established and growing (no tree stakes).

Decide on the project title. The title will be visible to the public but can be changed for any plaques purchased for clients.

Gather information needed to address the questions below:

- ✓ What was the client's intent, and what goals or outcomes did they want to achieve?
- ✓ Describe the scope of work and your company's approach to delivering the project or service.
- ✓ Describe any existing conditions, constraints, or challenges encountered before or during the project or service, and how they were addressed.
- ✓ How did the completed work or ongoing service successfully meet the client's goals and expectations?
- ✓ On a scale of 1 - 10, how would you rate the overall complexity or level of difficulty of the project or service?
- ✓ List which elements of the project your company self-performed and which elements were subcontracted.

Choose the best photos. Submit high-resolution photos in JPEG format. Include before photos whenever possible, as they are important to the judging process. Limit drone images to no more than one or two per entry. Photos should primarily feature work that was self-performed by the company. Clean properties before photo shoots. Do not include company names, logos, or any other branding on submitted images.

Create a photo caption for each photo. Provide a clear, concise description of what is in the photo. This is your opportunity to walk the judges through the project as if they were touring the property in person.

For Design/Build projects only - Include a detailed design plan in PDF format. Please make sure there is no company name/logo on the design plan.

Review your entry. Details matter and make a difference between award levels. Check for any spelling and grammatical errors.
