Documents needed...



- OSHA Form 300A – Summary of Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses (please provide one per branch when submitting for multiple locations).
- Vehicle Loss Run Report/Vehicle Claims Summary Report

Prepare to answer the following safety performance questions based off your 2025 data...



- Total number of vehicles in your company fleet (*licensed vehicles only*).
- Total miles driven by fleet (*optional*).
- Total number of vehicle accidents that involved personal injury and/or vehicle damage in excess of \$500. (*Include even those accidents in which your vehicle was legally parked, or the driver was not at fault, they will not be counted against the overall score.*)
- Total number of vehicle accidents reported above that occurred **only** while your vehicle was legally parked, or the driver was not at fault.

Refer to OSHA Form 300A for the following:



- Total number of employees.
- Total number of hours worked by all employees for the period of January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025. Include full-time, part-time, and seasonal employees. (*Round to nearest whole number.*)
- Total number of injuries and illnesses—refer to lines G–J on your OSHA Form 300A. (*Do not include accidents only requiring first aid, as defined on the OSHA Form 300A.*)
- Total number of days of job transfer or restriction—refer to line L on your OSHA Form 300A.
- Total number of days away from work—refer to line K on your OSHA Form 300A. A fatal accident is to be recorded as 6,000 days away from work. (*Round to nearest whole number.*)

Overall Safety Practices Checklist

Does your company practice the following? These points will count towards receiving an Overall Safety Achievement Award.

- Our company is a member of the National Association of Landscape Professionals. *Membership includes access to safety resources such as our Safety Advisor, newsletter and training tools.*
- Our top management has a strong commitment to safety. We have an in-depth company safety policy, which is reviewed and updated annually, or as needed, and is communicated to all employees in a language and manner they understand.
- Our company has a formal written and hands-on fleet safety-training program. Each driver must meet the company criteria of acceptable standards before the individual is allowed to operate equipment and vehicles.
- Our company complies with applicable OSHA and other safety-related regulations, including, but not limited to, OSHA's Hazard Communication Standard and OSHA's posting, record keeping, and reporting rules.
- Our management provides the resources necessary for a safe workplace, including, but not limited to, providing personal protective equipment (PPE) and enabling employees time to be spent on safety meetings and safety training.
- Our company has a formal written reporting system in place for all work-related injuries, illnesses, and near-miss accidents. This reporting system includes prompt investigation and follow-up by management.
- Our company is a Drug Free Workplace, enforces a zero-tolerance policy, and has a workplace policy that authorizes random drug/alcohol testing in accordance with the law.
- Our company has a written return-to-work or transitional work program, with job descriptions of potential return-to-work or transitional work.
- Our company has an effective system of recognition for positive, safe behaviors.
- Our company conducts regular tailgate safety training with our crews. Sessions are conducted orally in a language the workers understand and attendance logs are kept of all tailgate sessions and safety meetings.
